



GENERAL ROLL OFF PROCEDURES

Roll off placement must be on hard, dry base away from all water wells, water lines and septic fields.

Roll off cannot be placed near utility lines that are above and below ground.

GFL is NOT liable for property damage. Due to weight & nature of containers, they may leave ruts.

GFL is NOT liable for increased weights due to rain, snow, hail or flooding.

Customer is responsible for covering containers during inclement weather to avoid excess weight charges and/or "dig out" fees.

Total weight of any material in roll off, regardless of size, cannot exceed 16,000 pounds.

Do not fill container above rim, contents must be level for driver to tarp the truck.

Any damage to GFL roll offs, caused by the renter or renter's contractor, will be charged to the renter.

When disposing of concrete and brick, fill container only 1/2 full due to weight of material.

There will be a \$20.00 charge per mattress.
